Definition of *ditch* (Entry 1 of 2)

: a long narrow excavation dug in the earth (as for drainage)

ditch **verb**

ditched; ditching; ditches

Definition of *ditch* (Entry 2 of 2)

transitive verb

- a** : to surround with a long narrow cavity in the earth : to enclose with a ditch (see DITCH entry 1)
// The pasture was hedged and ditched.

b : to dig a ditch in
- aviation* : to make a forced landing of (an airplane) on water
// successfully ditched the plane
- a** : to get rid of : DISCARD
// ditch an old car
// had to ditch their plan

b : to end association with : LEAVE
// ditched school
// His girlfriend ditched him.

intransitive verb

- : to dig a ditch
- aviation* : to crash-land at sea
