Definition of *ditch* (Entry 1 of 2)

: a long narrow excavation dug in the earth (as for drainage)

ditch verb

ditched; ditching; ditches

Definition of ditch (Entry 2 of 2)

transitive verb

- a : to surround with a long narrow cavity in the earth : to enclose with a ditch (see <u>DITCH entry 1</u>)
 // The pasture was hedged and *ditched*.
 - **b** : to dig a ditch in
- 2 aviation : to make a forced landing of (an airplane) on water // successfully ditched the plane
- 3 a : to get rid of : <u>DISCARD</u> // ditch an old car // had to ditch their plan
 - b : to end association with : <u>LEAVE</u>
 // ditched school
 // His girlfriend ditched him.

intransitive verb

- 1 : to dig a ditch
- 2 aviation : to crash-land at sea
