


toys, it is important to check and choose ones that contain non-toxic paints.

There are also concerns about the PVC phthalates from vinyl found in some toys, which are known to cause lung, kidney, liver, and reproductive organ damage.

### **Risk to the Environment**

Plastic toys, especially the cheap ones, pose a great risk to the environment. Since they are not recyclable, they go into landfills and may take years to degrade.


