

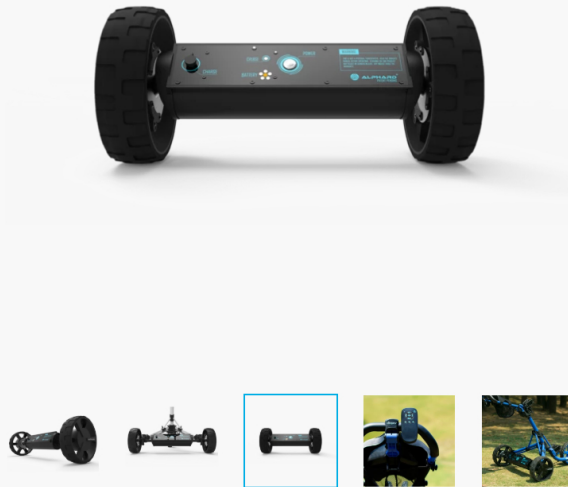

#### Okay but not great

Got the eWheels in July and began using them in August. Within 3 weeks, the clamps failed. eWheels promptly sent a new set, no questions asked. Good customer service.

The course I play is very hilly. Stability of the cart going uphill is an issue. It will fall backwards if I don't hold onto the handle. Also, I have problems getting the eWheels to run at my pace. It is either 1/2 step too slow or 1/2 step too fast. On the plus side, despite the course being very hilly, the battery life is excellent. The battery always shows plenty of power after 18 holes.

Finally, there is a long walk between 9 and 10. Previously, I could often get a ride between tee boxes from fellow players. Now, I have to walk since even if I turn off the eWheels to disengage it, the system doesn't run free enough to allow the push cart to be pulled while riding in a cart.

Does it work on grass?

**What problem were you?**

I have had my eWheels for about a year now I guess, and it is easily the best golf purchase I have made in a long time, perhaps ever. I use it with a Rovic cart with a swivel front wheel. Without the eWheels I would get backache from pushing a cart, so I often resorted to riding a cart. If I wanted to play well. Now I can walk 18, getting much more exercise and shooting better scores in the process.

The Rovic + eWheels combo I use easily lasts an entire round and although I have never played 27 with it I have little doubt it would make it based on the estimate charge left after 18. Even on hilly treks like Chambers Bay, it has had zero trouble through 18 holes with plenty charge left over.

Tracking is not bad but I do need to keep on top of it with the swivel front wheel. If I lock the front wheel in position it will wander much much less but in turn I get less maneuverability. I tend to leave the front wheel unlocked so the cart can turn on a dime when needed and I just give some course corrections as necessary along the way. If Alphard were to release an all-in-one solution with active front steering I would be all over it in a heartbeat. Alternatively it would be seriously cool to see an updated model with a built-in compass and more active tracking based on that. (Happy to test that for you Alphard :))

For the price however, the existing solution should be a no-brainer to anyone looking to walk the course more often. Your health will thank you for it!

**Tracking problems??**

I've had my eWheels for approximately 5 months now and still think it's the best thing since sliced bread. What I can't believe is how many people complain about tracking problems. It's not the fault of your eWheels and it's an incredibly easy fix. Mine tracked terrible the first time out as well and I agree, it will make you crazy. But all that's required is a wrench and/or screwdriver to adjust your cart's front wheel tracking. If you no longer have your cart's instruction booklet, simply Google their tracking instructions. In my opinion, the best way to make the adjustment is to take the tools with you to the course and fine tune it there. I hope this helps alleviate your frustration and concerns. Now get out there and enjoy golf again as God had intended.

**Very Happy After One Full Year...**

I purchased directly from Alphard for my SunMountain Microcart... After a full year of ownership, used up to 3 times a week on a very hilly course, I am happy to report this booster is everything I hoped for. It functions perfectly, no issues with pulling whatsoever. Battery consistently has plenty of charge left after 18 holes, and recharges quickly. Only glitch was at the very beginning with the remote: If the AAAs aren't snug the remote doesn't communicate with the unit. Customer service recommended tucking a bit of cloth over them and securing the cover with an elastic band, which solved the problem. Highly recommend!

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
