earned value ma...	<p>1. General: Clearly defined starting point (point of departure) from where implementation begins, <u>improvement</u> is judged, or comparison is made.</p> <p>2. Contracting: Basic <u>proposal</u> submitted in <u>response</u> to a <u>request for proposals (RFP)</u>. See also <u>acquisition program baseline</u>, <u>contract budget baseline</u>, and <u>performance measurement baseline</u>.</p> <p>3. Surveying: Surveyed line (running east and west; the longitudes or meridians run <u>north</u> and <u>south</u>) from which the <u>location</u> of a <u>building</u>, geographical <u>feature</u>, or territorial and <u>maritime</u> zones, etc., are measured and referenced. Also called <u>latitude</u>.</p>
