(General Industry Stats 2019)



Grape Production

- Grapes are the highest value fruit crop in the US
- Grape production is valued at over \$6.5 billion
- 36% of the value of non-citrus fruit grown in the US are from grapes
- US has nearly one million acres of grape-bearing land (wine, table grapes, and raisins)
- Over 7,500,000 tons of grapes were produced in the US in 2018

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Wine Production

- Over 900,000,000 gallons of wine produced in 2017
- California makes 85% of all US wine
- US accounts for 12% of the world's wine production
- The US leads the world in wine consumption
- In January 2019, there were 10,043 wineries in the US

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Exports

- US wine exports reached \$1.46 billion in value in 2018 *
- 95% of US exported wine comes from California
- Volume shipments reached 375 million liters or 41.7 million cases *
- The top 5 markets are the European Union, Canada, Hong Kong, Japan, and China
