Cost of Attendance

Robert Morris University

The Robert Morris University Financial Aid office establishes standard student budgets each year as a basis for awarding financial aid funds. These budgets are based on actual tuition charges, national average living allowances calculated by The College Board, and include direct and indirect costs for the academic year (Fall and Spring semesters).

The following cost of attendance example is based on the following assumptions:

All tuition charges are for full time, flat rate undergraduate students.

On Campus Dorm room and board awards are based on students who live on campus in a double occupancy room and choose the Patriot meal plan.

On Campus Apartment room and board awards are based on students who live in an apartment on campus and choose the Patriot meal plan.

Commuter - a student that resides at home with parents/relatives

Off Campus - a student that lives in an apartment or their own home
