# ARGUMENT(S)

This responds to the Office Action issued on February 4, 2015, for the Application to register AMAZON REGISTRY SERVICES ("Applicant's Mark") in Classes 35, 42 and 45 ("Application"), by Amazon Registry Services, Inc. ("Applicant").

#### **DISCUSSION**

## I. Cited Applications and Registrations - Single Source & Unity of Control

The Examining Attorney refused the Application under Trademark Act Section 2(d), 15 U.S.C. §1052(d), citing the following trademark registrations and applications, all owned or filed by Amazon Technologies, Inc. ("Cited Marks"):

- AMAZON, U.S. Reg. No. 3868195
- AMAZON.COM, U.S. Reg. No. 4608470
- AMAZON LOCAL REGISTER, U.S. App. Ser. No. 86364998
- AMAZON & Design, U.S. App. Ser. No. 86364995

A close relationship between associated companies will obviate any likelihood of consumer confusion between the companies' trademarks, as the public will perceive the parties' corresponding goods and services as emanating from a single source. *See In re Wella A.G.*, 787 F.2d 1549, 1552, 229 U.S.P.Q. 274, 276 (Fed. Cir. 1986); *In re Wella A.G.*, 5 U.S.P.Q.2d 1359, 1361 (T.T.A.B. 1987); Trademark Manual of Examining Procedure ("T.M.E.P.") §1201.07. In addition to this close relationship and the consumer perception that the parties' goods and services emanate from a single source, the parties must also exercise a unity of control over the use of the parties' trademarks. *Wella*, 5 U.S.P.Q.2d at 1361. Closely related sister companies, which share a common parent and operate under identical trademarks, can create the necessary consumer perception of a single source of goods or services and avoid any likelihood of consumer confusion between the companies, their trademarks, and their corresponding goods or services. For example, T.M.E.P.

\$1201.7(b)(iii) explains a scenario where both an applicant and a registrant offer related goods or services under the same trademark, are closely related sister companies, and each is owned by a common third-party parent company. This relationship between the companies and the shared use of similar trademarks can create the consumer perception that the parties' goods and services emanate from a single source, rather than individual entities, avoiding likelihood of consumer confusion. *See id*.

Similarly, here, Applicant and Amazon Technologies, Inc. are closely-related sister companies. Both Applicant and Amazon Technologies, Inc. are owned by the same parent, Amazon.com, Inc. and all three companies offer goods or services under the shared AMAZON-formative family of trademarks. When encountering Applicant's Mark and the Cited Marks, consumers will understand that the services offered by both Applicant and by Amazon Technologies, Inc. under their respective AMAZON-formative trademarks emanate from the same source, namely "Amazon", which obviates any likelihood of consumer confusion between Applicant's use of Applicant's Mark and Amazon Technologies, Inc.'s use of the Cited Marks. Therefore, Applicant respectfully requests the Examining Attorney withdraw the Trademark Act Section 2(d), 15 U.S.C. §1052(d) refusal.

#### II. Request for Suspension

In the event the Examining Attorney does not withdraw the refusal of the Application under Trademark Act Section 2(d), 15 U.S.C. §1052(d), Application Ser. Nos. 86364998 and 86364995 have not yet matured to registration and Applicant respectfully requests that further action on the Application be suspended, pending final disposition of these cited applications. 37 C.F.R. § 2.83(c); T.M.E.P. § 716.02(c).

Applicant respectfully requests the following amendments to the identification of services:
