



re our beginning in 1988, the ELCA has been one church body organized in three ressions — congregations, synods and the churchwide organization. Each expression has particular functions but all three together share a common mission of doing God's work in world and proclaiming the good news of Jesus Christ. Together, they ensure a solid addition of leadership, active involvement in communities, opportunities for dialogue and arse perspectives, creative partnerships, and support for members and ministries of the A.

churchwide organization is based out of the Lutheran Center in Chicago and functions the ELCA's 65 synods and nearly 10,000 congregations across the 50 states, Caribbean U.S. Virgin Islands. The churchwide organization's work and functions are guided by the rchwide Assembly, the Church Council and four elected officers. Its staff and elected ters work at the Lutheran Center and in other locations around the world serving as inistrators, advisors, conveners, partners and resource people for the ELCA and its istries.

ELCA also nurtures important connections with Lutheran, ecumenical and interfaith ners, and related organizations. We work alongside 26 colleges and universities related ne ELCA, eight seminaries, more than 2,000 schools and early childhood education ters, campus ministries, outdoor ministries, social service agencies, and other agencies institutions across the country and throughout the world. The churchwide organization is guided by the biennial Churchwide Assembly, the Church Council and the four elected officers of this church.

The churchwide organization also has staff who work from the Lutheran Center in Chicago, Ill., and from locations around the globe. Staff members serve as administrators, advisors, conveners and resource people for this church and its ministries. Each of its individual departments (called "units," "offices," and "sections") shares a common goal to advance the mission of the ELCA.
