SLEEP LOGIC® LIMITED WARRANTY

(See list above for duration of the warranty on the specific SleepLogic® mattress or box spring which you purchased.)

WHAT IS COVERED?

Your warranty covers manufacturing defects in your SleepLogic® mattress or foundation. This warranty is limited to the consumer who originally purchased the product. The following items are covered under normal wear:

Mattress

- Coils or wires that are loose, broken or protruding through the fabric
- Sagging, only if the mattress has been continuously supported by matching foundation (or equivalent) and used with an appropriate frame and center support, or a minimum of 5 hardwood cross-slats with center support
- Fabric handles sewn to mattress
- Body impressions of 2" or greater on both sides of mattress (or on one side for a single-sided mattress)

Foundation

- Splits in the wood frame
- Bent, loose or defective wood beams and/or center support rail
- Compression or unstapling of boxspring coils
- Broken or loose boxspring coils
- Sagging, but only when continuously supported with an appropriate frame and center support, or a minimum of 5 hardwood cross-slats and center support

WHAT WILL SLEEP LOGIC DO?

If your SleepLogic® mattress or foundation fails due to manufacturing defect, SleepLogic® will, at its option, either repair or replace the defective item.

Replacement or repair of one piece does not automatically result in the replacement or repair of another piece. SleepLogic® reserves the right to substitute comparable materials or models and does not guarantee that the replacement will match the defective piece.

HOW LONG IS THE WARRANTY COVERAGE PERIOD?

The warranty is for a period of time based upon the code on your law label (see chart above) starting with the original date of purchase. Repair or replacement of the mattress or foundation does not extend this warranty period or begin a new limited warranty period.

During the "free" period of your warranty, SleepLogic® will repair or replace the defective piece at no charge (except for transportation costs to and from our factory in Cleveland, Ohio). After the "free" period has expired, all repairs or replacements will be done on a pro-rated basis, based upon the current retail prices of the model purchased, or comparable model.

WHAT IS EXCLUDED UNDER THIS WARRANTY?

This warranty does not apply to items such as, but not limited to:

- Normal body impressions of 2" or greater on only one side or 2" or less on both sides of mattress
- Commercial Use
- Comfort or Firmness preference
- Product that is shipped outside of the continental U.S.
- Product that is stained, burned, in an unsanitary condition, or otherwise abused
- Product not maintained in accordance with the Care Instructions in this warranty card
- Full XL, Queen, or King sized bedding that is used on a metal frame, bed base or rail system (headboard/footboard) that does NOT have a rigid center support and at least 5 legs or 5 hardwood cross-slats
- Fabric (cover)
- Bent foundation or mattress border/edge wires
- Corner guards

THE FOREGOING LIMITED WARRANTY IS IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING ANY WARRANTY OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE OR MERCHANTABILITY. IN NO EVENT SHALL SLEEP LOGIC® BE RESPONSIBLE TO PAY FOR ANY SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL OR EXEMPLARY DAMAGES. Some states do not allow limitations of implied warranties or the exclusion of incidental or consequential damages, so the above exclusions may not apply to you. This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

WARRANTY AND CARE INFORMATION



IMPORTANT CARE INSTRUCTIONS

DO turn your mattress regularly using the turning instructions below (Cycle 1 for one-sided mattresses, Cycles 1 and 2 for two-sided mattresses). The resilient materials used in your mattress are designed to conform to your body's individual contours. This is not a manufacturing defect. By turning your mattress every two weeks for the first six months and once every month thereafter, these body impressions which form naturally on the mattress surface over time, will be equalized.

DO carry your mattress flat on its side - it's easier to handle and less likely to cause damage.

DO keep your bedding clean. Soiling or staining your mattress will invalidate your warranty. The use of a mattress pad is suggested.

DO replace the box spring when purchasing a new mattress because old box springs lose their strength and support. What appears to be a sag in your new mattress may well be a result of a faulty or weakened boxspring. A boxspring that does not provide proper support to your new mattress will invalidate your mattress warranty.

DO use a metal bed frame. For Full XL, queen and king sized bedding, the use of a rigid center support is required.

DO NOT bend your mattress more than 20 degrees; such treatment may damage the innerpring unit. Flex rather than bend the mattress when going through doorways, and don't bend the corners when putting on fitted sheets.

DO NOT allow anyone to stand or jump on your mattress. It was not built to withstand that type of weight concentration.

DO NOT allow your mattress to get wet. Protect it from water, dry cleaning fluid, or other liquids.

DO NOT smoke in bed or place product near open flame. This mattress is manufactured, as required by law, to resist ignition from lighted cigarettes but not open flame.

Rotation Cycle 1

1. Rotate mattress counter-clockwise 1/2 turn.
2. Realign mattress with foundation.
3. Raise mattress on edge
4. Rotate and realign mattress with foundation.

Rotation Cycle 2

1. Rotate mattress to overhang foundation.
2. Raise mattress on edge
3. Lower mattress gently.
4. Rotate and realign mattress with foundation.

PLEASE DO NOT ATTEMPT TO TURN YOUR MATTRESS BY YOURSELF. This may cause injury to you or damage to your mattress.

WHAT TO DO SHOULD A DEFECT OCCUR

If a defect occurs in your SleepLogic® mattress or box spring, you should immediately contact the dealer from whom you made the purchase. Be prepared to furnish him with the following information:

- Name of the SleepLogic® mattress or box spring
- Proof of purchase with date
- Explanation of defect
- Arrange for inspection and return product with retailer.
