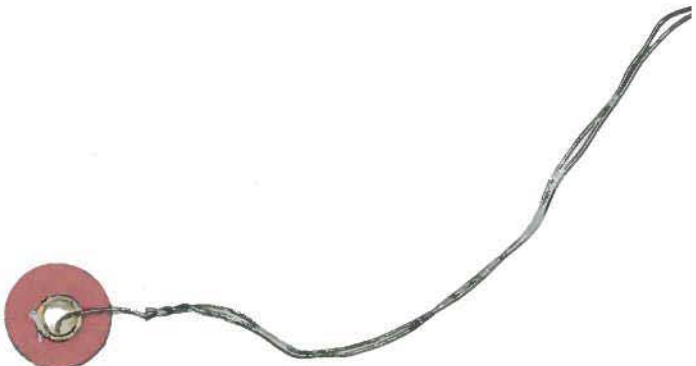

**FIRST AID:**

### PRECAUTIONS:

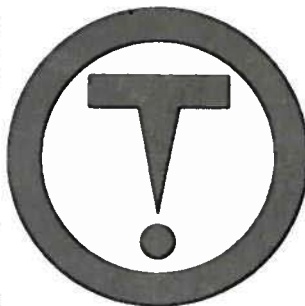
