

Cart Assembly Instructions for ATB[™] – All Terrain Bucket System

Parts contained in package include:

Part # on diagram

- 1 Powder coated Steel frame section with handle
- 2 Powder coated Steel Base frame section
- 3 Base cross tube
- 4 Steel Mounting Plate
- 5 Wheel Assembly* (Please use a hand pump to inflate tires. 5-6 pumps will be enough)
- 6 Hand grip
- 7 Cap Plug (already installed)
- 8 Hex Head Cap Screw (already soldered on Base)
- 9 Flat washer (Large size)
- 10 Hex Acorn Locknut with Nylon Insert (Large size)
- 11– Hex Head Cap Screw
- 12- Flat washer (Small size)
- 13- Hex Acorn Locknut with Nylon Insert (Small size)

Line up (1) Steel frame section with Mounting plate (4) and insert flat washer (12) then hex head screw (11) into the top hole, put additional washer (12) on the other side of tubing , followed by hex acorn locknut (13) and tighten with wrench (make sure handle (6) is facing away from base frame (2). Do the same on both mounting plates.

Insert flat washer (9) over hex head cap screw (8) and then insert wheel assembly. If difficulty getting wheel on then turn wheel around and reinsert or try wheel on opposite axle. Insert additional flat washer (9) and then insert hex acorn locknut (10). Tighten with a wrench making sure not to overtighten or else the wheel will not spin. Repeat these steps for the wheel on the other side.

Stacking Buckets

You are now ready to stack your two covered buckets onto the cart, making sure that the grooves on the bottom of the first bucket fit snugly with the cross tubes (3) of the base frame. The second bucket fits snugly over the bottom bucket too. You can attach a bungy cord for added support by hooking around the frame of the cart.

To Attach the ATB[™] – Tool Caddy to the frame

Unfold the Cotton canvas ATB Tool Caddy. With pockets facing towards you, attach top straps around handle bar and smooth the Velcro straps together. Follow these same procedures for the side straps and frame of the ATB Cart. The ATB Tool Caddy should fit snugly around the cart and should not get in the way of stacking the buckets. Remember, the Tool Caddy is made of heavy duty cotton canvas and is machine washable, but please remember to hang dry to avoid excessive shrinkage.
