



**E**notria, part of the Graziano Family of Wines, is what the ancients called Italy. We produce wines from Italian grape varieties that are native to the Piemonte region of northwest Italy. We utilize the best methods, both modern and ancient, to create wines that are distinctly Californian yet evocative of their Italian heritage.

**Arneis** Piemontesi winegrowers call this grape "little rascal" because it is so difficult to cultivate and vinify. We love it because of the distinctive aromas and flavors of sweet apples and ripe Bosc pears. Traditionally the most important white grape variety in the Roero district of Piemonte, Arneis has found a happy home here next to the Russian River in Mendocino County. 100% fermented in French Burgundy oak barrels gives this wine a rich ethereal feminine character. Enjoy this wine with grilled fish or lightly sautéed scallops.
