### Floor Tiles

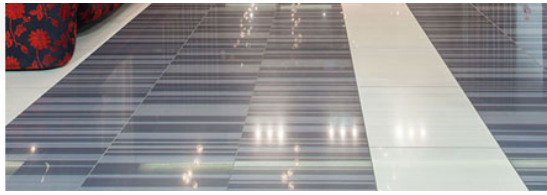
Floor tiles are made from a number of different materials, they come in different sizes, shapes, and colors. Some of the materials used in floor tiles include:

Because bathroom tiles can get wet it is very important that these tiles are prepared from





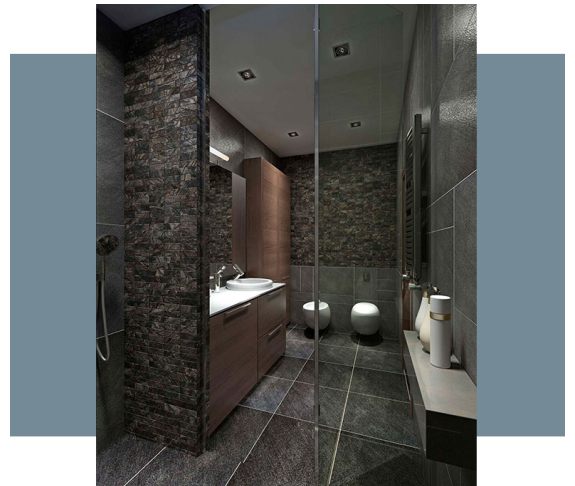
slip-resistant materials. Some bathroom tile materials include:
