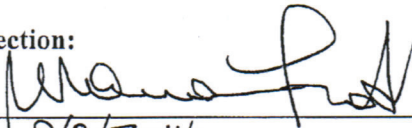

NOTE TO APPLICANT: When filed as part of the electronic form (i.e., scanned and attached as an image file), the signature page **must** include both the signature information **and** the boilerplate declaration language. Do **not** include the entire application, but do ensure that the boilerplate declaration language actually appears; *a signature by itself will not be acceptable*. If, due to browser limitations boilerplate declaration language appears on a previous page when printed, you must "merge" the declaration and signature block onto a single page prior to signing, so that the *one complete page* can be scanned to create an acceptable image file. It is recommended that you copy-and-paste the entire text form into another document, manipulate the spacing there to move the declaration and signature sections to a separate page, and then print this new version of the text form to send to the signatory.
