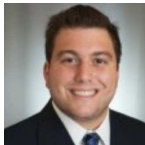

- Does it refrain from promoting religious, political or personal positions or being affiliated with external interest groups, such as political action committees? Interest groups cannot have an agenda that is controversial or promotes division among employees.

Some No-Go's and Friendly Reminders

- No gambling activities such as casino night or bingo, regardless of whether the games are played for merchandise, cash or charitable purposes
- No alcohol related interest group is allowed (for example, wine tasting events)
- Activities should not by nature be dangerous or hazardous to participants
- Cannot sponsor a community event or activity with another organization or company without the approval of local management
