Class 1:

Chemicals used in photography, as well as in agriculture, horticulture and forestry; unprocessed artificial resins, unprocessed plastic, manures, fire extinguishing compositions, tempering and soldering preparations, tanning substances, adhesives used in industry.

Class 6:

Transportable buildings of metal, materials of metal for railway tracks, non-electric cables and wires of common metal, pipes and tubes of metal, safes.

Class 7:

Machine tools, motors and engines (except for land vehicles), machine coupling and transmission components (except for land vehicles), agricultural implements other than hand-operated, incubators for eggs.

Class 9:

Scientific, nautical, surveying, photographic, cinematographic, optical, weighing, measuring, signalling, checking (supervision), life-saving and teaching apparatus and instruments; apparatus for recording, transmission or reproduction of sound or images, magnetic data carriers, recording discs; automatic vending machines and mechanisms for coin-operated apparatus, cash register, calculating machines and data processing equipment and computers, fire extinguishing apparatus; none of the aforesaid goods being computer hardware or software for data encryption purposes.

Class 12:

Vehicles, apparatus for locomotion by land, air or water.

Class 17:

Rubber, gutta-percha, gum, asbestos, mica and goods made from these materials and not included in other classes, plastics in extruded form for use in manufacture, packing, stopping and insulating materials, flexible pipes, not of metal.
