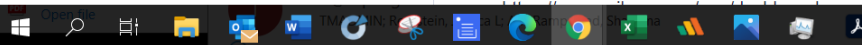
This document is meant to be an overview of all of the capabilities of Mailgun and how you can best leverage those capabilities. It is organized around the four major features that Mailgun provides:

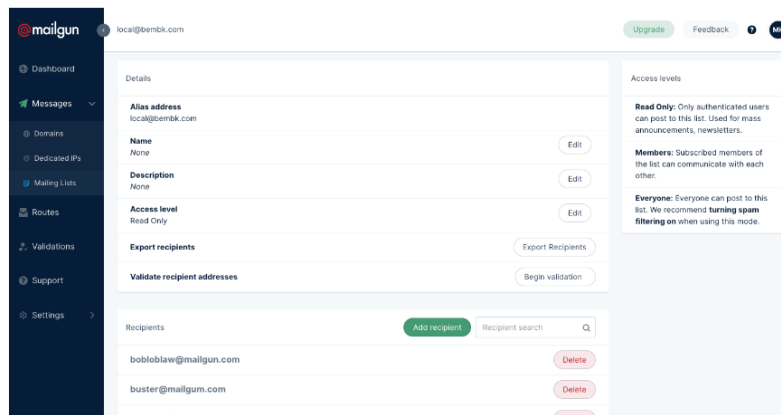
