About this Event

“What is needed is a realization that power without love is reckless and abusive and that love without power is sentimental and anemic. Power at its best is love implementing the demands of justice. Justice at its best is love correcting everything that stands against love.”

Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. wrote these words in his last book, *Where Do We Go From Here: Chaos or Community?*, which was published in 1967. The ideals shared within the quote are worth exploring to understand the connection between power, justice...and love.

In conjunction with our Be Love campaign, The King Center presents a 3-part training series that will feature a study of this quote and other Kingian teachings that can help us ‘Be Love’ to create the Beloved Community.

February 22, 2021 at 6:00 PM EST

Redefining Love: Love is not passive, but active. It works for justice and is a purveyor of true peace. Join The King Center for this session focused on exploring common concepts of love in comparison to love as defined and described by Dr. King in his speeches and writings.

February 23, 2021 at 6:00 PM EST

Revolutionary Love: Dr. King said, “A social movement that only moves people is merely a revolt. A movement that changes both people and institutions is a revolution.” He also asserted that we need “a revolution of values.” This session explores both quotes, and Dr. King’s teachings on love, to provide insight on the revolutionary power of love.
