## 'GoldRush' - Apple

**Origin:** A cooperative apple breeding program between Purdue, Rutgers and

Illinois Universities (PRI), U.S.A. Selected by J. Crosby, J. Janick, E.

Williams, D. Daniels, P. Pecknold.

Fruit size: Medium for season. Requires adequate thinning to achieve satisfactory

size.

**Shape:** Round to round-oblong.

**Skin:** A pale lemon-yellow colour with some slight light red blush on sun

exposed fruit. Smooth, with very conspicuous, russetted lenticel spots scattered on the surface. Thin slightly tender skin. Non-waxy skin finish can led to some skin shrivelling. Overseas reports suggest storing under

high humidity to assist with this problem.

**Flesh:** Pale yellow. Moderately firm. Slightly coarse texture.

Flavour: Slightly sprightly.

**Blossom:** Overseas reports mid-late season.

Pollination: Under evaluation in Australia. Possibly 'William's Pride', or any diploid

cultivar which blossoms simultaneously.

**Cropping:** Reported from overseas to be moderately productive. Can be biennial

bearing.

Tree habit: Reportedly to have moderate vigour, slightly upright and spreading. Good,

desirable habit. Semi-spur with very little blind wood.

Maturity: Estimated +5 days 'Granny Smith'.

Comments: Was selected by the PRI breeding programme for its disease resistant

characteristics. Shows promise in areas suited to its production and may

extend the season for growers looking for organic status.
