The Stone Soup Leadership Institute Announces the Young Heroes Fund to Support Multi-Cultural Activists

MASSACHUSETTS -- On June 26, 2020 The Stone Soup Leadership Institute is launching a **Young Heroes Fund**, to support young people who are on the front lines fighting for climate action, as well as for social, economic and environmental justice. Recipients will be drawn from youth featured in the forthcoming book, ***Stone Soup for a Sustainable World: Life-Changing Stories of Young Heroes***. This forthcoming book features 100 young climate change activists, social and environmental justice champions, green entrepreneurs/inventors, trailblazers, and “next gen” philanthropists.

The **Young Heroes Fund** will be launched at **Pre-Launch Book Party -- VIP Invitation-only global event**. It is the culmination of the Institute's 16th Sustainability Summit with amazing speakers from the book including Vanessa Nakate (Rise Up Africa), Jerome Foster II (OneMillionOfUs) and environmental social activist Jamie Margolin (Zero Hour) and Get Out The Vote Campaigns.

The Young Heroes Fund will provide support, mentors, training, and financial assistance to scale their organizations to reach millions of young people.
