What is SAgE?

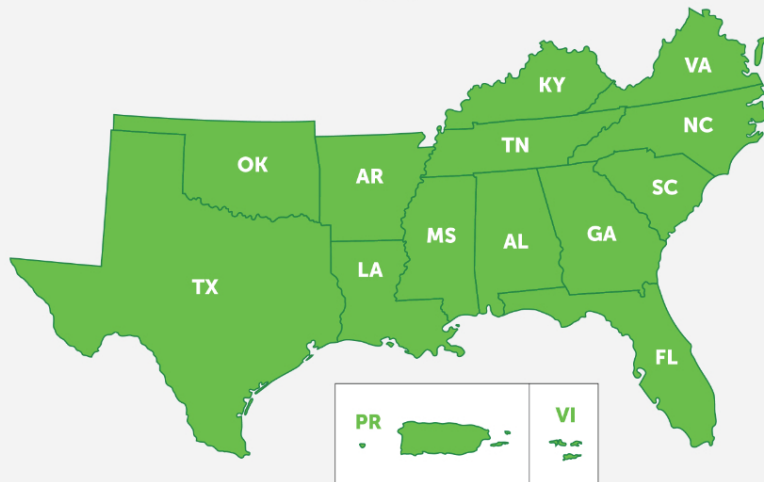
By coordinating resources to alleviate stressors, the SAgE Network supports the overall well-being of people in agriculture.
