Declaration of Mike Andrews

The above-identified registrant is the owner of cancelled United States Registration No. 76678462; the mark shown therein has been in continuous use in interstate commerce for five consecutive years from the date of registration, namely June 10, 2008, to the present on all goods identified in the registration as follows: Lighting products, namely, fixtures, lamps, chandelier crystal, chandelier pendants and chandelier accessories, namely, crystal chandelier parts, namely, crystal prisms, crystal pendants and other chandelier parts made from crystal, namely, crystal beads, crystal pendaloques, chandelier chains decorated with crystal beads, crystal bobeches, crystal candle cups, crystal body dishes, crystal chandelier arms, crystal chandelier bodies, crystal breaks and crystal columns and retail lighting store services. The mark is still in use in such commerce on said goods.

I have been the chief financial officer for Maxim Lighting International, Inc. since 2005. As part of my duties, I am responsible for maintaining our company's trademark portfolio. This includes reviewing and signing declaration that our registered trademarks are continuing to be used in commerce.

One of the trademarks that I am responsible for monitoring is the MAXIM design trademark. I worked with our trademark attorney, Mark J. Ingber. Mr. Ingber was our exclusive trademark attorney until 2008 when we began using Michael Pegues to maintain our trademarks. I was responsible for transferring our registered trademarks, including the Maxim design make, from Mr. Ingber to Mr. Pegues. I, however, overlooked the Maxim design trademark and did not transfer it to Mr. Pegues.

I recently learned that the Maxim design trademark has been canceled because Maxim did not file the appropriate document to prove that it has continued to use the MAXIM design trademark in the classification as registered. The cancelation was brought to Maxim attention by our current intellectual property attorney, Michael Pegues. Mr. Pegues' notification to me was the first time that I was aware that the proper paperwork had not been filed with the Trademark Office with the result being the cancelation of our MAXIM design trademark. I did not receive any notification from our prior trademark attorney, Mr. Ingber, that Maxim was required to file any paperwork to keep its MAXIM design trademark.

I immediately, upon learning of the cancelation, asked Mr. Pegues to do everything possible to revive the Maxim trademark.
