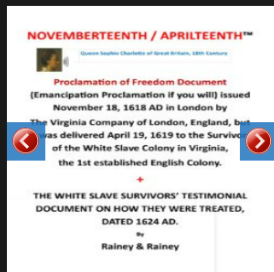


and **Reparations**, which serves as a legal precedent pointing to Reparations paid to the survivors, contrary to Reparations not paid, to date, to Descendants of African Slaves since the ratification of the 13th Amendment by the U.S. Congress in 1865 AD; the 2nd eBook, on the other hand, reflects the 1st eBook's major theme about the 1st 12 years of this English Virginia Colony, 1610 to 1619 AD, and also explains NPS's reason for titling the eBook: "Novemberteenth / Aprilteenth," while the 3rd eBook redresses NPS's claim that White Slavery existed underground in America for over 240 years, viz., The Virginia Colony, 1619 AD, until the Emancipation Proclamation was issued in 1863 AD.
