RESPONSE TO OFFICE ACTION

In response to the Office Action dated October 12, 2018, Applicant respectfully submits the following arguments in support of the application to register the subject trademark.

I. SECTION 2(D) REFUSAL - LIKELIHOOD OF CONFUSION (LIMITED TO CLASS 35 AND CLASS 32)

The Examining Attorney contends that Applicant’s mark is likely to cause confusion with the following registrations: U.S. Reg. 1003552 (‘552) for GO MART in Class 35 used in connection with “retail food store services”, and U.S. Reg. 4909267 (‘267) for GO in Class 32 used in connection with “Energy drinks; Energy drinks enhanced with coconut water and resveratrol.”


A likelihood of confusion inquiry is made on a case-by-case basis using the *du Pont* factors. See *In re E.I. du Pont de Nemours & Co.*, 177 USPQ 563, 476 F.2d 1357 (CCPA 1983).

While not every factor is necessarily relevant or of equal weight, the Trademark Office must consider pertinent evidence regarding any factor entered into the record. *Id.* at 568–69. The most compelling factors, namely the similarity of the goods and similarity of the marks may be outweighed by other factors, especially where there is probative fact evidence. *See* TMEP 1207.01.


A. DIFFERENCES OF THE MARKS IN APPEARANCE

“The test of likelihood of confusion is not whether the marks can be distinguished when subjected to a side-by-side comparison, but whether the marks are sufficiently similar that there is a likelihood of confusion as to the source of the goods or services.” TMEP § 1207.01(b) (citing *Midwestern Pet Foods, Inc. v. Societe Des Produits Nestle S.A.*, 103 USPQ2d 1435, 1440, 685 F.3d 1046 (Fed. Cir. 2012)). Marks must be compared in their entireties in terms of sound, appearance, meaning, and commercial impression. *In re Viterra Inc.*, 101 USPQ2d 1905, 1908, 671 F.3d 1358 (Fed. Cir. 2012); *Edom Labs., Inc. v. Glenn Lichter*, 102 USPQ2d 1546, 1551 (TTAB 2012).


In this case, the cited registration, GO MART (‘552), has the word MART which is

distinctly different from just the word GO as used in Applicant’s mark, . The cited mark has two words compared to Applicant’s one word design mark. Consumers will be able to differentiate the source of goods and services provided by GO MART and Applicant’s one word design mark, GO. Consumers will identify that the cited registration has an important second word, MART, and easily distinguish it from Applicant’s mark.



In addition, the cited registration , covering “Energy drinks; Energy drinks enhanced with coconut water and resveratrol” in Class 32 is substantially different in appearance than Applicant’s mark. The component similar to the subject application is the word GO. The cited registration consists of the word GO in white lettering with a very distinctive green honeycomb interior pattern in the circle mark. The cited mark has a very distinctive appearance that differentiates it from the Applicant’s mark.



Applicant’s  mark at first glance looks like a smiley face. The letters G and O give the illusion that the letters are the eyes of the design mark. The mark also consists of a curved arrow pointing to the right. Applicant’s mark, in contrast, consists merely of plain white letters on a colored background. Therefore, the marks are not visually similar when reviewed in their entireties.

Although greater weight is often given to the wording portion of a word and design composite mark, TMEP 1207.01(c)(ii) explains, “The Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit has cautioned, however, that ‘[t]here is no general rule as to whether letters or designs will dominate in composite marks; nor is the dominance of letters or design dispositive of the issue.’” Citing *In re Electrolyte Labs. Inc.*, 929 F.2d 645, 647, 16 USPQ2d 1239, 1240 (Fed. Cir. 1990). In this case, the appearance of Applicant’s mark and the cited mark are visually very different, and the design will weigh heavily in the minds of consumers.

Accordingly, at least because of the significant differences in appearance of these marks, there is no likelihood of confusion between Applicant’s mark and the cited mark.

B. COMMON ELEMENTS IN MARKS ARE WEAK

Though Applicant admits that the two cited GO MART and GO marks have a similar sound to the Applicant's GO mark, these common elements are weak. There are approximately *seventy-seven* marks on the USPTO registry that contain the word GO used in connection to Class 32. See Exhibit A. The fact that there are approximately seventy-seven co-existing registrations with the same GO component is indicative that GO is weak in the restaurant services and the beverage field. Under TMEP. § 1207(d)(iii), "third-party registrations may be relevant to show that a mark...so commonly used that the public will look to other elements to distinguish the source of the goods or services." Here, the common GO element is used so commonly that the public will look to other elements, such as the design of the marks, to distinguish the source of the goods or services.

Accordingly, at least because the common GO element between the cited marks and Applicant's mark is weak, there is no likelihood of confusion between Applicant's mark and the cited marks.

II. IDENTIFICATION OF GOODS

As requested by the Examining Attorney, Applicant requests amendment of the services description as suggested in the Office Action. The amendment to the description is requested in the applicable section of the response form to the following (additions in bold):

International Class 43; **Services for providing food and drink, namely,** restaurant and bar services;

III. III. SUMMARY AND CONCLUSION

Applicant has addressed all of the Examining Attorney's concerns, and believes the application is ready for publication. In weighing the above *du Pont* factors, Applicant asserts that the totality of the facts supports registration. The difference in appearance and the common elements are weak. As such, there is no likelihood of confusion, and Applicant requests the Examining Attorney withdraw the refusal to register on this ground.
