RESPONSE TO OFFICE ACTION

Responsive to the Office Action dated April 30, 2019, the period for responding set to expire October 30, 2019, the Applicant responds as follows:

REMARKS

Applicant is pleased to note that the Examining Attorney's search of the Office records uncovered no similar registered or pending mark which would bar registration under Trademark Act Section 2(d), 15 U.S.C. Section 1052(d). The Examining Attorney has however raised various informalities, which Applicant addresses below. Accordingly, Applicant believes that the Application is now in a position to proceed to publication pending the issuance and submission of the corresponding foreign registration certificates.

Identification of Services

The Examining Attorney has taken the position that certain wording in Applicant's identification is not sufficiently definite and has required amendment thereof. Accordingly, by amendment herein, Applicant has amended the identification, substantially adopting the suggestions of the Examining Attorney.

Entity

The Examining Attorney has required that Applicant specify its country of organization. Accordingly, Applicant states, per *TMEP* § 803.03(a) that it is organized under the laws of Mexico.

Foreign Registration Certificate

The Examining Attorney noted the Applicant's dual filing basis, namely a bona fide intention to use the mark in commerce under Trademark Act Section 1(b), 15 U.S.C. Section 1051(b), and claiming priority under Section 44(d), 15 U.S.C. Section 1126(d), based on a

foreign application.

Applicant wishes to maintain the dual filing basis, and advises that the Mexico applications upon which this application is based in part remain pending. Copies of the corresponding registration certificates will be provided to the Examining Attorney upon issuance.

Accordingly, it is submitted that the present application is fully in condition for publication pending issuance and submission of the corresponding foreign certificates. Further and favorable action placing the application in suspension is respectfully requested.
