Definition of *Mafia*

(Entry 1 of 2)

1a: a secret criminal society of Sicily or Italy

b: a similarly conceived criminal organization in the U.S. also: a similar organization elsewhere the Japanese Mafia

c: a criminal organization associated with a particular traffic the cocaine Mafia

2 often not capitalized: a group of people likened to the Mafia especially: a group of people of similar interests or backgrounds prominent in a particular field or enterprise: clique


