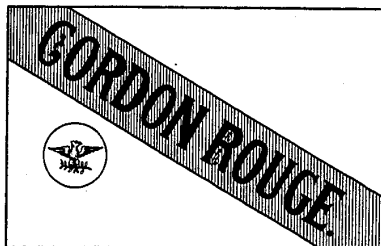

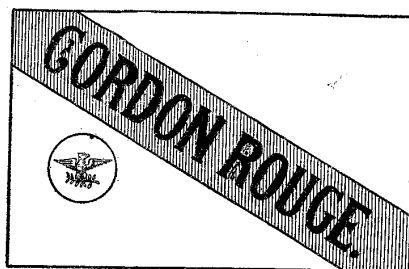

STATEMENT

To the Commissioner of Patents:

Be it known that Societe Vinicole de Champagne, a corporation of Paris and Rheims, France, and having its principal place of business at 63 Avenue de Champs-Elysees, Paris, France, has adopted for its use the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for CHAMPAGNE WINES, in Class 47, Wines, and presents herewith five specimens showing the trade-mark as actually used by the applicant upon the goods, and requests that the same be registered in the United States Patent Office in accordance with the act of February 20, 1905, as amended. The trade-mark has been continuously used in the business of said corporation, and in the business of its predecessor, G. H. Mumm & Co., since the 23rd Day of March, 1883.

The drawing is lined for red.

The trade-mark is applied or affixed to the packages containing the goods, by placing thereon a printed or lithographed label, and in other manners, on which the trade-mark is shown.

Applicant is the owner of the following trade-marks: 58,835, G. H. Mumm & Co., December 25, 1906; 97,345, G. H. Mumm & Co., June 2, 1914.

Said trade-mark has been registered in France, No. 204,157, dated August 18, 1921.

Applicant is the owner of certificate of registration No. 177,419, Societe Vinicole de Champagne, dated December 18, 1923.

G. H. Mumm Champagne (Societe Vinicole de Champagne, Successors) and Associates, Inc., La Maison Francaise, 610 Fifth Ave., New York, N. Y., is designated as the party upon whom process or notice of proceedings affecting the right to ownership of said trade-mark brought under the laws of the United States may be served.

The mark has been in actual use as a trade-mark by applicant and its said predecessor in business for ten years next preceding February 20, 1905, and such use has been exclusive.

The undersigned hereby appoints C. P. Goepel, registered patent attorney, 165 Broadway, New York, N. Y., its attorney, to prosecute this application for registration with full powers of substitution and revocation, and to make alterations and amendments therein, to receive the certificate, and to transact all business in the Patent Office connected therewith.
