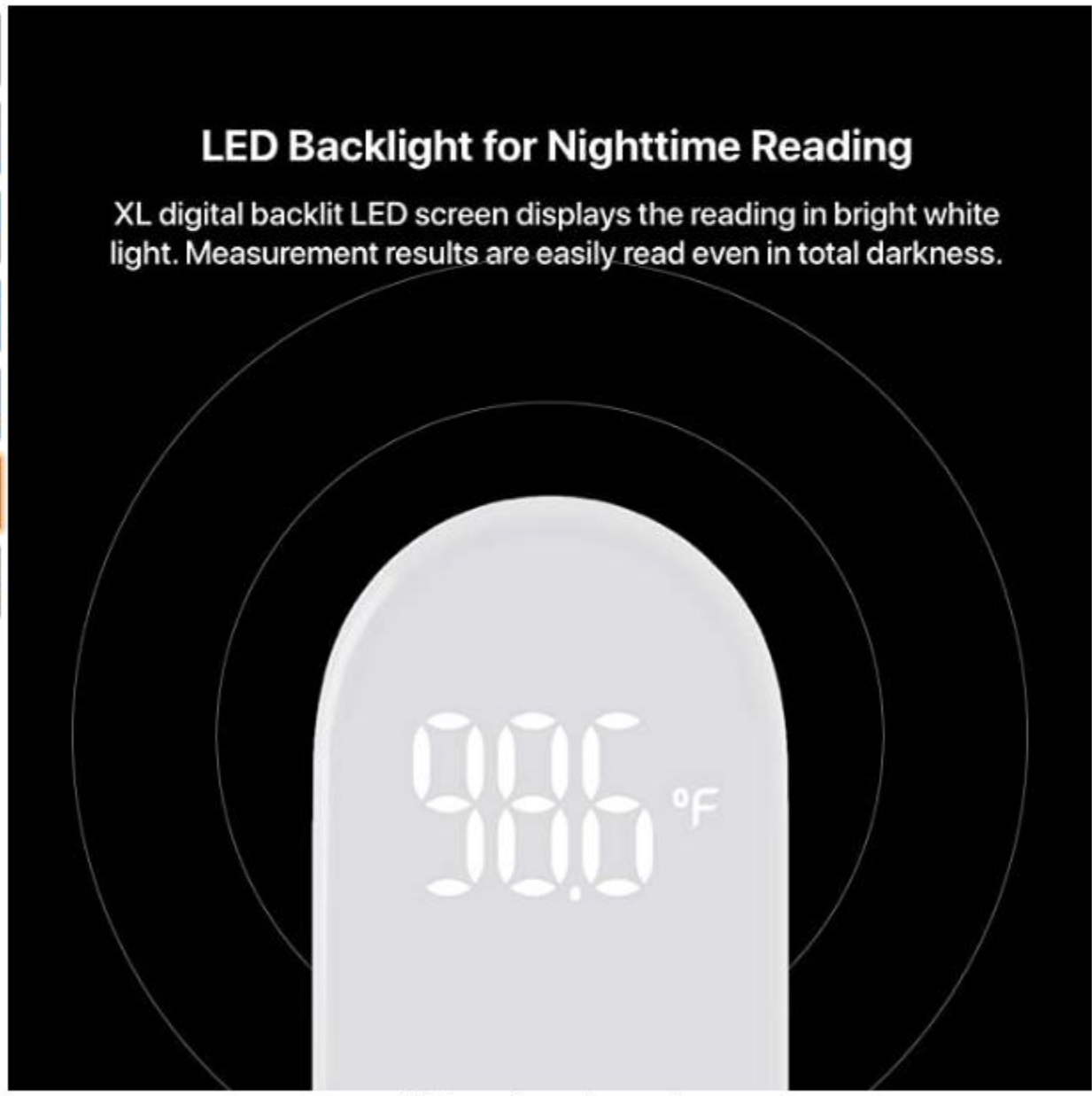

Decided to replace the trusty Braun thermoscan ear thermometer that we bought back in 2007 when our first child was born. The Thermoscan wasn't broken, just that it feels outdated. This No-Touch thermometer is really well-designed. Simplistic, and intuitive to use.

Daughter just came down with a mild cold, and we have been using both the old Thermoscan and this No-Touch thermometer to see if there is any difference in the reading. While this is not a affirmative test for accuracy, both thermometers' readout are within 0.3 F of each other, so we are fairly confident that both of these are good for their function.

Using the No-Touch thermometer:

While holding the No-Touch thermometer close to forehead (without touching), press the button once to activate. Once the No-Touch thermometer vibrates, the scan is complete.

There are similar No-Touch thermometers out there for a bit cheaper, but I enjoy the design of this particular model.

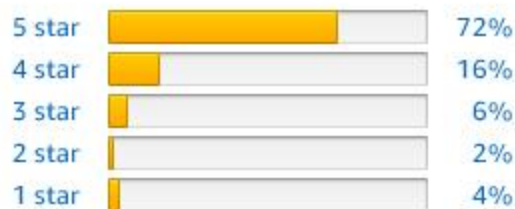

I truly appreciate that the iHealth blood pressure monitor works straight out of the box. It starts taking blood pressure with one-button, and the on-device display is easy to read. It even color codes how your blood pressure correlates to accepted standards for hypertension. It is a 5-star blood pressure cuff.

However, I have to give it a 4-star rating and almost gave it a 3-star rating. The app seems to require a login that requires a bunch of personal information. Apple already has all of that in Health app, so I don't want to provide it to a company who just makes my blood pressure monitor. Also, I couldn't figure out how to get the app to send the data to Apple Health without setting up an account with iHealth. The app setup was a bit cumbersome too; I am very technologically literate and live my life on my smartphone. However, as some other reviewers have commented, the way that the app is set up would throw my dad off and result in him not being able to use the smart features. The monitor is easy to setup and use. The device is fairly simple- one button connects it to your bluetooth device for tracking and the other button starts or stops the test. The manual mentions that the cuff comes in two different sizes, but I only saw the regular size available. It could be a bit clearer on how to wrap the cuff around the arm (that it should go through the metal slot and back around), but overall the instructions are helpful. It also contains a helpful chart so you can interpret the blood pressure results. Once the test is done, you do have to manually sync it with a device if you want it tracked (or you could take the test without tracking). I assume it has to be manually synced to save battery juice. The app was easy to set up on my Galaxy 7 (Android phone) and I had not trouble uploading my data. The problem came when my wife then took the test. I discovered that there is no way in the app to differentiate between different users. If my wife wants to track her data, she would need to upload it to her own phone with a separate account. The app should be able to assign test results to different users on the same account, and since that's an app function, it's a feature they could add in a future update.

The monitor itself is super easy to use, very intuitive. Basically, just slip on the sleeve (aligned per the diagram on the cuff itself) and press the button. My mom (familiar with home blood pressure devices but not this brand) knew how to use it without instruction.

I installed the app and paired the device easily on my mom's phone, but when I tried to show her how to back up her info, of course the blue tooth started getting fussy, and I had to click back and forth several times, and I realized I was going to have to sync it for her. If an app doesn't work consistently, my mom will get flummoxed and refuse to use it. If you're using this for older parents who aren't confident with tech, they may not use the app, though the monitor is meant to store data that can be uploaded later (I couldn't find a number in the documentation, but typically these machines store about a hundred readings).

Since it seemed to be a bluetooth issue, I can't be sure whether it's the app (which isn't highly rated) or my mom's phone, so I didn't want to ding the monitor too much for a crummy app--though I do have to knock off a star, since this is marketed for its "connectivity." I can say they would do a service to their older clientele by making single-purpose versions of their apps for individual product categories. Most senior users would rather have a simple, single-screen blood pressure app than a highly nested category app for all ihealth products. I do use the ihealth app myself for their scale, and I find it fairly reliable, but not always super- intuitive, if I haven't checked in for a while.

I was hoping to have a continuous monitor sharing element. My dad had a Dexcom blood glucose monitor, and it was great for other family members to be able to keep an eye on his blood sugar in case he was ignoring it. This does have the typical ios share option, but it's just to share a fixed set of info, not continuous account monitoring. My mom's high blood pressure is fairly well controlled, so this isn't a dealbreaker for me, but would be nice for other families.

All in all, a solid standalone monitor, and a good connected monitor to anyone comfortable fiddling around with less-than-perfect apps.

I have become a bit of a connoisseur of blood pressure meters after personal and family medical issues, with the only type that I really trust being the manual cuff and stethoscope. However, for daily readings and particularly with older family members, the digital variety are more convenient. Even if the readings are a little high or low, they are useful for tracking changes over time. In my short experience with this meter, it is not far off my manual and doctor's office readings. The cord is a bit shorter than my others, which is not a problem for my setup. The cuff is easy to put on by myself without pinching my skin.

To use it, you can just hit the button and the cuff will do the rest, displaying the results. This is all you need if you just want to keep paper records. For an easier way to keep track of readings over time, you can download the app, which also allows sharing. I think this option could be simpler for having an older parent or friend share results than the memory function on typical meters, which often have unintuitive menus.

iHealth now has a BP monitor that can be used without the app! The cuff inflates quickly and gives you the BP reading fast. Screen display is good, color coded for BP and easy on the eyes. They also claim to detect arrhythmia -irregular heartbeat. The readings are fairly accurate and comparable to Welch-Allyn.

You can transfer the readings to smartphone app and from the app, the blood pressure chart can be saved as PDF, CSV or Excel file and emailed to your provider; however, the app does not share the data with the Microsoft HealthVault, only Apple health. The app requires you to set up a separate ihealth account and definitely needs improvement. As priced now, at \$38, the price is reasonable - even better than Omron.

Looks like iHealth got the hardware right but they definitely need to work on the app and make sharing with electronic medical records, HealthVault, Health app easier. Wrist monitors are easier to use and becoming very accurate.
