Jerusalem is packed with world-renowned sites and attractions. But here are a few of our "insider's" attractions you may not have heard of:

Lights In Jerusalem

See the Old City in a truly different light. Artistic, creative and at times startling uses of light, conjured up by artisans from around the world, will bathe the walls, doorways and sometimes entire edifices of the Old City as part of the Lights In Jerusalem festival. Runs each night from June 11-19, 2014. Free.

Tens of thousands have flocked to the Old City during the festival's first three years. This year's exhibition has expanded to include ten international artists' displays. www.lights-in-jerusalem.com.

La Traviata at Masada

And while we're at it, here's another ancient site with a modern twist on art. Giuseppe Verdi's "La Traviata" will be performed on perhaps its grandest stage ever — at the base of Masada. Masada is located within easy reach of Jerusalem by car or bus (about 90 minutes each way). Reviews of previous operas at Masada have called them "jaw-dropping" and "magical". June 12-17, 2014.

Entering its fourth year in 2014, opera performances at Masada have been noted for their with cuttingedge 4-D video technology and expansive lighting. www.latraviata-at-masada.com

Bloomfield Science Museum

And to balance out the arts with some science, the Bloomfield Science Museum is an informal, hands-on museum/exhibition geared towards kids (of all ages). Play, interact and learn. Makes for a nice air-conditioned break from the mid-day sun. Current featured exhibits include: "Can A Computer Fall In Love?" and "Exploration of Illusions".

Teddy Park

With the walls of Old City as a backdrop and situated just outside the Jaffa Gate, Teddy Park includes Israel's only sound and light water fountain. The water pulses and splashes for 10 minutes starting on the hour from 8am each day. The water-light-sound show is free and starts at 8pm and 9pm. The park honors the memory of Jerusalem's legendary Mayor Teddy Kollek.

Zikit – Family Adventure Park

Newly opened Zikit calls itself a "family adventure park" and offers activities for all ages including challenge ropes course, pedal go-carts, laser tag and a gymboree for the youngest adventurers. Many more activities are scheduled to open during 2014. Located in Maale Adumim, it's open Sunday-Thursday 9:00am-9:00pm, Friday 9:00am-1:00pm, and from one hour after the end of Shabbat until 11:00pm. For more details: www.zikit.net or call *2303.

First Station

Located in the heart of Jerusalem, on the site of the city's first train station built 120 years ago, First Station is a hub for entertainment, activities and, of course, food. Open seven days a week, there's something going on at all hours including a "culinary bazaar", once-a-week Tai Chi, Pilates and Zumba classes, a hula hoops workshop, and gigantic soap-bubble blowing for kids (of all ages). www.firststation.co.il

Night Spectacular – Sound and Light Show at the Tower of David

The Old City's Tower of David Citadel courtyard is the venue for a visually stunning and creative celebration of Jerusalem's history. The Night Spectacular, a 45-minute show, uses trompe l'oeil technology in which the storied stones and structures of the courtyard's walls dissolve into scenes of additional stories from Jerusalem's past. Accompanied by original music, the show envelops its viewers.
